REPORTS TO DISTRIBUTION FOREMAN

GENERAL-PURPOSE

Performs a variety of semi-skilled and unskilled manual duties in the laying and repairing of cast iron, steel, PVC, copper, galvanized, or concrete pipelines; building and maintenance of structures appurtenant to pipelines responsible for general maintenance of Company property, buildings, grounds, and equipment; responsible for maintaining and utilizing current working knowledge and technical skills applicable to the specific requirements of this position

ESSENTIAL DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

- Performs skilled and unskilled work such as lifting, digging, carrying, backfilling, mixing concrete, grounds, road repairing, trenching, concrete and asphalt repair, landscaping, and snow removal.
- Places lay, repairs, and connects pipe (ranging from large water transmission main to service lines), hydrants, valves valve boxes, etc.
- Performs the reading and recording of meters and computes consumption.
- Keeps a constant vigilance for violations of Company regulations, including reporting dead meters; fills out/generates proper company paperwork necessary in association with the repairs or alteration of water service facilities.
- Loads and unloads material transported by various vehicles, properly placing, piling, or storing such material or equipment.
- Assists in building and repairing valve vaults and other structures appurtenant to pipelines
- Operates light equipment such as trucks, air compressors, pavement breakers, tampers, pumps, and related equipment; repairing, oiling, and greasing such equipment as instructed
- Operates Company vehicles and two-way radio in the performance of duties following Company standards
- Responsible for the proper use and care (including preventive maintenance where applicable) of all Company property utilized in the performance of duties to assure safe and efficient operation; also responsible for reporting the need for repair on all such property to the immediate supervisor; follows Company policies, rules, and procedures as outlined in the Employee Handbook

- Performs other duties as assigned

- Basic knowledge of and ability to use essential construction equipment/tools and displays a mechanical aptitude for utility construction.

Graduation from High School; equivalent experience may be substituted

Valid Colorado Driver's License required at time of hire and obtained a Commercial Driver's License within six months of full-time employment.

Zero to One year in pipe installation and repair and/or a display of aptitude and ability for such work;

MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT DIRECTLY USED

Light-duty trucks, backhoes, air compressors, pavement breakers, compaction equipment, tampers, pumps, grinders, tap machines, vices, lawnmowers, weed eaters, hydraulic shoring, and assorted hand tools; performs the placement of dirt, concrete, asphalt, and sod, and any other materials of the job

WORKING ENVIRONMENT/PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES

Poor; frequent hazardous exposure around construction projects, heavy equipment, ditches, traffic, and weather conditions; must be able to ascend and descend vertical ladders and steps; must be able to hear alarms in emergency traffic conditions; must be able to lift and carry at least 125 pounds

HOURS – COMPENSATION

Regular business hours (7:30 AM to 3:30 PM); frequent overtime; ability to be placed on the on-call emergency leak repair rotating schedule; hourly compensated
